MicroStation Tip

New tool, look, and Key-in for Power Selector in V8.

New Tool

In the Power Selector dialog box there is a new icon in the Mode section (arrow with star). The 'New' icon will automatically deselect the previous selection set and then select the new elements. This will help the users from forgetting to deselect the selection set each time before moving onto the next modification tool.

New Look

The expand arrow at the bottom of this dialog has a new look. Now the Levels, Color, etc. are in a nice tab format. If you want to select all the elements on a certain level go to the level tab and select the level name. If you want to narrow your selection to a particular level and color use the CTRL key when selecting.

New Keyin

There are two new keyins that work with selection sets. CHOOSE PREVIOUS and CHOOSE LAST. After you spend time creating your selection set then deselect the elements you can now get the previous selection set back. From the Keyin browser type in 'choose previous' to get the entire selection set. If you want just the last element selected keyin 'choose last'. These are great little keyins!

Don't forget the spacebar can also be used to deselect items.

InRoads Tip

Using decision tables yet?

Did you know that you can have negative distance entries in a decision table that allow you to work *towards* the reference line? Just keep in mind that if you use a negative distance value, the positive/negatives for slopes also get reversed (+ runs down-slope). A sample case for using this might be to establish a slope intercept 10' inside a right-of-way line. Use your imagination!
