## Change Screen

Clicking on the Bentley logo in the upper left hand corner of a view window will give you access to handy shortcuts for level display, view attributes, saved views, and other functions.



This will work on all 8 MicroStation views.

## InRoads Tip [top](#)

### InRoads

Are you tired of browsing to directories for opening and saving InRoads data files?

Use File>Project Defaults to define default paths for individual project data files.

Project defaults are stored in the Windows registry on the PC you are working on. Want to share your project defaults with others? Using the [Export] button on the Project Defaults dialog will create a 'registry' file. This exported file is an ASCII file that can be opened with any text editor (like Notepad) if you wish to review the contents. Once created, you can either [Import] (once again on the Project Default dialog) or execute the file by double-clicking on it to update the Windows registry file.

This also works great when you get a new PC. No need to re-input all that information.
