



lower case to UPPER CASE Using a key-in

Need MicroStation text converted from lower case to uppercase? Do you Retype it? We hope not.

Delivered with MicroStation V8 there are example Visual Basic for Applications (VBA). One of those VBA routines allows you to change text from lowercase to UPPERCASE. Using MicroStation configuration Variables you can auto load any VBA and then run it with a key-in.

Here is the Setup:

1. From the MicroStation pull-down menus select **Workspace>Configuration**
 - Category [Visual Basic for Application]
 - Names of Standard Projects
2. Use the **Select** icon.
 - Path to C:/Program Files/Bentley/Workspace/System/vba/examples/TextExamples.mvba
 - **OK**
 - Restart MicroStation

Here is the Key-in:

3. In the Key-in Browser, type “vba run [projectname]”
 - vba run changecase

Notes:

1. You can load multiple VBA Projects using the configuration variable:
MS_VBAAUTOLOADPROJECTS
2. Now that we have the VBA Project auto loading, all we need is the key-in.
3. You can also start a VBA with the Alt+F8 keyboard shortcut.
